PILGRIM'S MUSIC ENSEMBLES NEED YOU! Do you enjoy singing or ringing handbells? There are several ways to share your music talents in worship. Consider joining Adult Choir, Combo Group, or Pilgrim Ringers. Adult Choir will beain its singing season with its first rehearsal on Thursday September 15th, 7-8:30pm in the choir Adult Choir rehearses each Thursday room. during the school year and sings each Sunday, typically at 10:45am worship though once a month at 8am. Combo Group is an ensemble of singers and instrumentalists that leads 10:45am worship on the second Sunday of every month, and rehearses the Wednesday evening prior to that Sunday. Pilgrim Ringers, directed by Kevin Donley, rehearses each Thursday during the school year from 6-7pm and plays periodically in worship. FLORIST CHANGE—Many of you have probably noticed that the flowers we have been receiving have been of VERY inferior guality. The Board of Directors voted to change florists to Oberer's, located on Old Meridian St in Carmel. You will be pleased with the product they will provide us. Like everything, inflation has won out again. The cost of the flowers will basically double but we will be getting more than double the value in flowers. The total cost per arrangement will be \$40.50. The flower chart is full for the rest of the year. We will not ask those who have signed up to make up the difference unless they so choose. The current cost has been \$21.00 per arrangement. You will not need to return the vase. To those who put flowers in the church: first, THANK YOU from the entire congregation - they add so much to our sanctuary and services; and second, following second service, please take them home, to a friend, hospital, nursing home, etc. They need to be enjoyed. The florist guarantees the flowers for five days but said they usually last much longer.

AN OPPORTUNITY TO SERVE! - Acts 12:6a tells us that, "We have different gifts according to the grace given us," and verse 7 follows with, "If it is serving let him serve; if it is teaching, let him teach." One of the most rewarding things I have ever done is present the chalice to anyone with the words, "This is the Blood of Christ, shed on the Cross for you." That is just one of the roles of the lay assistant during a worship service, and it is indeed a joy to perform. Lay assistants also share the Word of God (teaching) by reading the lessons during a service. Come and share in the joy. ORGAN FUND UPDATE—As of August 1, 2016 we have collected \$182,871 of \$266,867 in pledges/donations toward our new organ. Currently, we have 29 open pledges. NEW ORGAN UPDATE—On 7/29/16, several organ committee members participated in a 'field trip' to John-Paul Buzard Pipe Organ Builders in Champaign. It was exciting to see how our new organ is coming together. The organ console where Sarah will be seated is completely assembled. The organ case that will house the pipes is partially completed. All the organ pipes (2,130 pipes!!) are in the shop, and the 'voicing' of those pipes has begun - meaning each individual pipe is hand adjusted to play the exact pitch, tone and quality. We also saw the room where Buzard will assemble our new organ - pipes and all. The instrument will then be disassembled and remains on schedule to arrive at Pilgrim early January 2017. It will take approximately six weeks to reassemble the organ and another six weeks to adjust the instrument to it's new home. So, if you look at your 2017 calendar you will realize our music on Easter Sunday will be fantastic! Please check our website, as well as the screen in the narthex, for updated pictures.
