This will be a great opportunity to get to know Pastor Heidi better, to ask questions, and for her to learn more about each of us. WHAT'S UP IN WORSHIP—This Sunday we have a special proclamation of the first lesson. Isaiah 6:1-8 recounts Isaiah's vision, with the famous conclusion of "Here I am, Lord, send me!" Today our choirs will bring this scripture to musical life. At 8 a.m. the Adult Choir will sing an old choral setting of this text, David McWilliams' *In the Year that King Uzziah Died*. It brings the imagery of the six-winged seraphs and a house filled with smoke to life in a rather dramatic fashion. At the 10:45 worship, the Combo Group will sing Martin Luther's hymn that paraphrases this reading and will add a modern twist to it at the end. One of Pilgrim's music program goals is to use music to proclaim the Holy Scriptures in new and amazing ways to you. I hope you enjoy a musical interpretation of this reading.

SUPER SENIORS—Join us at noon on Tuesday, February 19, for our Super Seniors luncheon. We have invited Frank Grunwald to return and speak with us about his experience in a Nazi concentration camp. This is about a 45-minute presentation, complete with some visual aids.
