ADULT SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASS in January and February led by Pastor Paul Schumacher: Our Forefathers in the Faith. A 5-week study on this topic begins for all adult Pilgrims on January 28, 2018. Pastor Paul Schumacher, long-time member of Pilgrim and moreover a faithful servant to Pilgrim as he has served in the Interim Pastor capacity for us many, many times. Pastor Paul will begin the classes with a discussion of St. Augustine (354-430 A.D.) drawing from his books *Confessions* and *City* of God. Continuing on Pastor Paul will focus on Martin Luther, a young Augustinian monk (1483-1546) with his 95 Theses (1517) and The Augsburg Confession (1530) with colleague Philip Melancthon. The last three classes will be devoted to Our American Experience of Lutheranism, with references to Soren Kierkegaard (1813-1855) and Dietrich Bonhoeffer (1906-1945). Coming to each session will give you a broad view of Lutheran history but even attending several sessions will be enriching if you are unable to attend all five.
