WHAT'S UP IN WORSHIP—Today is a rather special Sunday! This is the beginning of the epiphany season in our liturgical calendar. Epiphany means "manifestation." The Christian church remembers the manifestation or revelation of Christ to the Gentiles, as represented by the three Wise Men following the star to the manger in Bethlehem. What's special today is that the first Sunday in epiphany actually IS the festival of Epiphany - January 6 marks the 12th day of Christmas (think twelve drummers drumming and eleven pipers piping etc., etc...). In most years the festival of Epiphany does not fall on a Sunday and our lectionary moves right from Christmas to Baptism of Our Lord (which is next Sunday, January 13.) So in our scriptures today, the wise men arrive at the manger and we get to sing all Christmas hymns that mention wise the You earn extra credit if you can explain what frankincense and myrrh are!

WORSHIP LEADERS NEEDED

Pilgrim is in need of additional people of all ages to serve as Sunday worship leaders as ushers, lay assistants and communion assistants.

Ushers - Serve on a team for a month at a time normally three times per year. Ushering is a great opportunity for newer members to meet people when passing out bulletins. Families may want to consider serving as an entire team!

Lay Assistants - Usually serve six to eight services per year and are responsible for reading the first and second scripture readings and participating in communing the congregation. Do you enjoy reading and helping bring the Word of God to the congregation? Then serving as a Lay Assistant is a great role for you!

Communion Assistants- Principally serve in worship services where continuous line communion occurs. This role does not require reading like the Lay Assistant but is every bit as important to enhance the congregation's worship experience.
