WORSHIP LEADERS NEEDED

Pilgrim is in need of additional people of all ages to serve as Sunday worship leaders in the roles of usher, lay assistant and communion assistant.

<u>USHERS</u> serve on a team for a month at a time, normally three times per year. Ushering is a great opportunity for newer members to meet people when passing out bulletins. Families may want to consider serving as an entire team!

LAY ASSISTANTS usually serve six-to-eight services a year and are responsible for reading the first and second scripture readings and participation gin communing the congregation. Do you enjoy reading and helping bring the Word of God to the congregation? This serving as a Lay Assistant is a great role for you!

<u>COMMUNION ASSISTANTS</u> principally serve in worship services where continuous line communion occurs. This role does not require reading like the Lay Assistant, but is every bit as important to enhance the congregation's worship experience.
