WHAT'S UP WORSHIP—WHAT'S UP IN WORSHIP? This Sunday is the third Sunday of Pentecost. While there are many Sundays in the Pentecost season (this year the season stretches from June 9 through November 24) I can spot this Sunday a mile away. When I see Psalm 16 pop up as one of the scriptures I know exactly which Sunday this is. Our scriptures are determined by a three-year cycle called the Revised Common Lectionary that is shared by churches around the world. Every three years we repeat the cycle. This collaboration began in the early 1990s just as I was beginning to play the organ. On the second Sunday of Pentecost in 1992 I turned the legal working age of 14 and on the third Sunday in Pentecost I began getting paid for playing the organ for worship. On that Sunday the last verse of Psalm 16 had been printed on the worship bulletin's cover: "You will show me the path of life; in your presence there is fullness of joy, and in your right hand are pleasures forevermore." Many years later I came across that bulletin and thought that was a very appropriate psalm verse for me as I had made a career out of being a church musician. I suspect that we all could think of a particular scripture passage or verses that have spoken to us over the years and when we open the worship bulletin and see it printed are reminded again of its importance. ~Sarah Williams
