Pilgrim Lutheran Preschool And Parents Time Out





"From the Elders"

Elder's Cor I recently provided a reference letter for a friend seeking new employment. pondered what I was going to say in the reference letter to the new potential employer, emphasizing the attributes I had experienced and witnessed. As I looked at my friend's business card, identifying his title, place of employment, address and contact information, I realized that all too frequently what is listed on our business card, handed out freely at meetings and events, is the only information many people know about us. It does not reflect who we really are, but only identifies what we do professionally.

If there were such a thing as a "business of life" card, I wonder what mine would say. What would I want people to know about me? While my job is important and provides for my life style and living expenses, it is not who I am. I think my business of life card would have on it: husband, father, grandfather, father-in law, son, brother, son-in-law, friend, angler, bicycler, kayaker, volunteer, tinkerer and Christian.

While Christian would certainly be on my business of life card, would it be first on my list of attributes? It should be, for being a Christian, believing in Jesus Christ, supersedes everything else. Thinking about this gives me pause as all too often I am caught up in the other aspects of my life and do not give my faith and belief the attention it deserves. I do not witness and share my beliefs with others as I should and I am not sure everyone I know understands how important my faith and Christian beliefs are to me. I am quick to let others know about other aspects of my life, but not as quick to share my love of Christ and what he has done in my life.

With God's help, I will continue to work on being a better witness and example for Christ. I will continue to strive to move Christian to the top of my business of life card on a daily basis, taking time to not only ask for his guidance, but to thank him for all he has done and continues to do.

Will your business of life card have Christian on it? Will it be at the top of your list, in the middle or at the bottom?


