NEW ADULT SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASS **CONTINUES**—"The Road to Emmaus-Revisited". Susie Pike continues an adult Sunday School class that runs through Palm Sunday. The title of the class is "The Road to Emmaus-Revisited." and begins with the passage in Luke 24 where two of the disciples encounter the risen Jesus on the road to Emmaus. Unaware of Jesus' identity, the disciples begin to share the story of what had happened in Jerusalem those three days before and how they were disappointed that Jesus had not been the hoped for Messiah who would redeem Israel. Jesus quickly calls them to task for not understanding the scriptures that foretold the Messiah would suffer and die as part of God's salvation plan. "And beginning with Moses and the Prophets, he interpreted to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning himself" (Luke 24:27). Throughout the five weeks of class, we will consider the overall picture of the Old Testament and look at the many different ways in which Christ is revealed as the key to its overarching story, the unfolding story of redemption that would eventually embrace the whole of creation, time, and humanity in its scope.
