PILGRIM GARDEN UPDATE—Although it's been a very wet spring we've made some progress over the past two weekends and have some of the tilling completed. The east end is still very wet, so: ***No more rain!!*** (Until June perhaps) Still, some planting should be able to start in another week or so. As we have mentioned in earlier updates, we'd like to be able to put a fence around the garden to keep critters from munching all our hard work. We've been able to raise \$500 so far, but the project will need about \$1750 to complete.
